One effect of the austerity which I did not then know was the sharp rise in mortality rates.

Normally the Greek government publishes the figures monthly but stopped last year.

The increased death toll is the result of poverty, lack of heating, malnutrition, the de-funding of the Greek National Health Service and so on.

Coming from a reliable source like the ambassador, the figures carry weight. These figures are approaching those during the famine which occurred under Nazi occupation - and prompted the foundation of the Oxford Committee for Famine Relief (now OXFAM)
